The 2868th session of the Council of the European Union - **EDUCATION**, **YOUTH and CULTURE** - will take place on 21 (14.30) and 22 (10.00) May 2008 in the Justus Lipsius Building, Brussels, under the Presidency of Mr **Milan ZVER**, Slovenian Minister of Education and Sport and Mr **Vasko SIMONITI**, Slovenian Minister of Culture.
