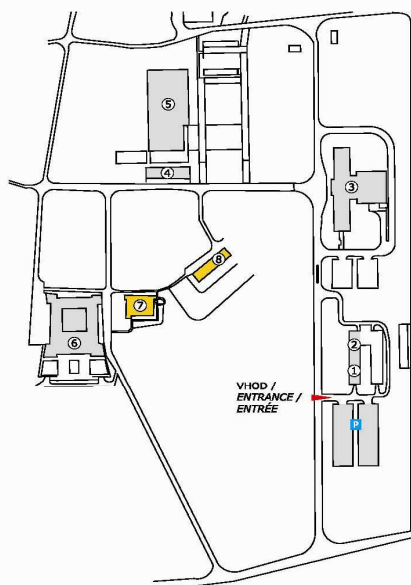

Press Centre

A permanent Press Centre during the Slovenian Presidency is located at the Brdo Estate, 200m from the Brdo Congress Centre.

The standard equipment of the Press Centre includes 200 workstations, of which 20 are equipped with PCs with internet access, telephones, fax machines, printers, and photocopiers.

The workstations will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis.

Stations are equipped with 220V power outlets. Laptop computers can be plugged directly into RJ 45 sockets for high-speed internet access via a LAN. WiFi will also be available.
