LAST-MINUTE ACCREDITATION EUROPEAN COUNCIL Brussels, 19/20 June 2008

Journalists who have not applied for accreditation by the deadline (by 12.00 on Wednesday 4 June 2008) may apply for last-minute accreditation on-line via the website: http://www.consilium.europa.eu/eucouncil-si-late accreditation.

For security reasons, last-minute accreditation requests will be subject to comprehensive verification by the Belgian authorities; the Security Office of the General Secretariat may also check the bona fide character of applicants with their editors-in-chief/producers. These checks may cause long delays. If you follow the late accreditation procedure, you are advised to arrive at the accreditation office well in advance.

- Tuesday 17 June 2008 (09.30–13.00 and 14.00–17.00)
- Wednesday 18 June 2008 (09.30–13.00 and 14.00–19.00)
- Thursday 19 June 2008 (09.00–20.00)
- Friday 20 June 2008 (08.30-final press conference)

When you collect your identification badge, you will be asked to present the following documents:

- A. Journalists and technicians already accredited with the European Institutions:
 - (1) interinstitutional press card delivered by the Commission (= yellow card with red letter "P" for journalists, pink card with the words "Presse technique" for technicians)
 - (2) your valid passport or your national identity card (valid) issued by a Member State of the European Union, of EFTA or EEA countries
 - (3) for media representatives of Belgian nationality or registered resident in Belgium and who are registering for the first time in 2008: the <u>original</u> copy of your application for security clearance <u>signed</u> by yourself. (see our internet page: http://www.consilium.europa.eu/eucouncil-si-late accreditation).

B. Other cases

Documents to be presented:

- your valid passport or your national identity card (valid) issued by a Member State of the European Union, of EFTA or EEA countries **and**
- your press card or if you do not have a press card, an **ORIGINAL** letter (faxes will not be accepted!) from your media organisation, signed by the editor-in-chief, specifying your professional status **and**
- for media representatives of Belgian nationality or registered resident in Belgium and who are registering for the first time in 2008: the <u>original</u> copy of your application for security clearance <u>signed</u> by yourself. (see our internet page: http://www.consilium.europa.eu/eucouncil-si-late accreditation).

The assignment letter must be dated no more than 7 days before the start of the summit and must contain the following 5 items of information:

- 1. Date
- 2. Name of the media organisation and its contact details
- 3. Name of the editor-in-chief and his/her contact details
- 4. Name of the media representative in question
- 5. Reference to the identity document (passport, identity card, etc.) that will be presented for accreditation, its number and its period of validity.

Assignment letters which do not contain <u>all</u> the above details and which are not <u>originals</u> will be refused (specimen attached).
