The conference continues the process of reflexion in the area of research infrastructures started in May 2007, based on the results of the CREST Working Group on "*How to achieve better coordinated use of Framework Programme and Structural Funds to support R&D*" and the recent launch of the EC communication on "*Competitive European regions through research and innovation*".

The main objectives of the conference are to clarify the challenges and opportunities at the regional, national or inter-regional levels related to the development of research infrastructures of pan-European character (including the e-Infrastructure), to highlight their contribution to the Lisbon objectives (e.g. impact on industry, sustainable development, employment) and to review the recommendations for improving the financial engineering of research infrastructures for their construction and sustainable operation.
